RACE PACK COLLECTION

You can collect your race pack at Palazzo Pentagonovia A. Manzoni 22, Bormio

- Friday June, 2nd from 3 pm to 8 pm
- Saturday June, 3rd from 9 am to 8 pm

EVENT BRACELET

If you comply with all the requirements you will be given the GFSS event bracelet. You must wear it during the Granfondo weekend to be granted access to all the GF areas (expo, race pack collections, race grids, pasta party).

OFFICIAL EVENT BRIEFING

When: Saturday June 3rd 5.30 pm

Where: Palazzo Pentagono via A. Manzoni 22, Bormio. Follow the event briefing for useful info and advice or the event.

PARKING

We suggest you to park near the ski facilities (via Btg. Morbegno) or Centro Sportivo/Palazzo Pentagono.

GRANFONDO SCHEDULE

Granfondo Stelvio Santini start in Bormio, Via al Forte.

- Medium and Long Routes: 7.00 am
- Short Route / E-bike: will start straight after. Approximately at 7.40 am

Time limit in Bormio (before the start of the Stelvio climb): 2.30 pm (where: start of the Stelvio Pass climb)

Award ceremony: 4.00 pm Bormio, Palazzo del Ghiaccio

STARTING GRID

The entrance to the starting grids is at via al Forte

- Long and Medium Routes: from 5.15 to 6.45
- Short Route / E-bike: from 6.15 to 7.15 am

YOU MUST FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS DETAILED ON THE MAP FOUND ON PAGE 11 TO REACH YOUR CORRECT STARTING GRID

CLOTHING BAG

It is strongly recommended that participants bring a full set of winter cycling clothing – warm jacket, bib-tights, warm gloves and overshoes. You can put these items in your clothing bag, along with any other items you may need. This bag will be supplied when you register together with a race number sticker that you will have to attach to the bag. The clothing bags will be collected at the start and transported to the finish where they will be safely stored until your arrival. Some hotels in Bormio provide a collection service for the clothing bags the night before the Granfondo. We also suggest to add a backpack to your set of warm clothing. You can use it for your used cycling clothing during your descent to Bormio.

GRANFONDO START CONTROLLED SPEED

For the first km of the race the race director's car will drive in front of the participants keeping a controlled speed. After this point the Granfondo Stelvio Santini will start.

RACE NUMBERS

It's forbidden to cut, hide, write on or wrap your race number around your frame. You must place your bike race number on the front of your handlebars, extended and clearly visible, and your personal race number on the back of your jersey. The race chip will be given to you at race pack collection. It must be positioned underneath the saddle, on the seat-post.

You will have to return your chip to our staff at the finish on the top of the Stelvio in order to receive your clothing bag.

If you fail to return the chip you won't be able to participate to the next editions of the Granfondo Stelvio Santini. Improper use of the chip will result in the non-inclusion in the ranking and the non-attribution of the time. The race number and chip are strictly personal and not transferable to third parties – this will result in immediate disqualification.

Without the race jersey it will not be possible to access the starting grids and be assisted at the food stops and mechanical assistance points.

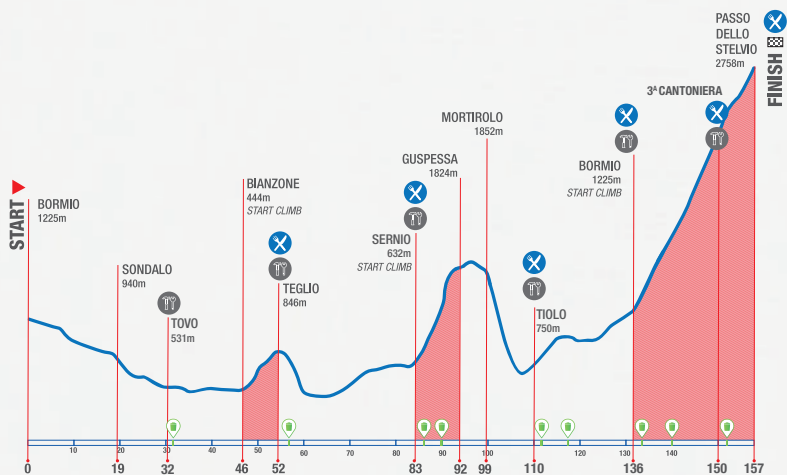
If you manage to complete your route and conquer the Stelvio, you will also receive an exclusive finisher cap!

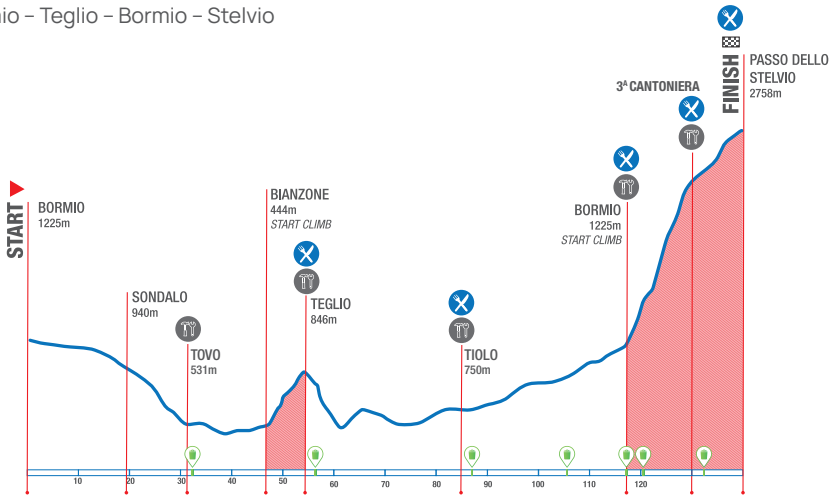

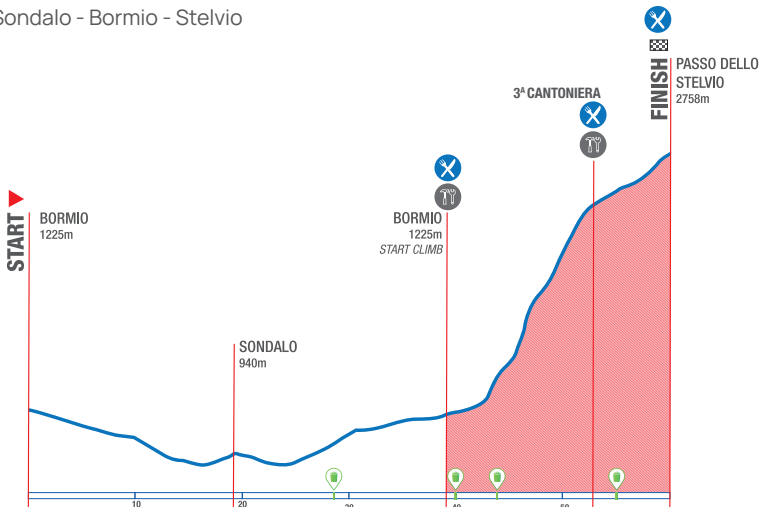

REPAIR SERVICE AREAS

There will be six repair service areas.

- Tovo
- Teglio
- Sernio
- Tiolo (at the food stop)
- Bormio (at the food stop in Piazza Combo)
- At the III° Casa Cantoniera on the Stelvio climb

Repair service areas will provide general assistance – not specific repair or replacement (in case of replacement of a piece, the cost will be charged to the participant).



MEDICAL SERVICE

Along the course there will be five roving ambulances with one additional ambulance stationed at the start/finish.



FOOD STOPS

There will be five refreshment areas along the race route:

- Teglio at 52 km.
- Sernio (just before the splits between long and medium routes) at 83 km.
- **After descending the Mortirolo climb** (for the long route) at 110 km.
- Bormio (before the start of the STELVIO climb), in Piazza di Combo (time limit zone) at 136 km..
- At the III° Casa Cantoniera on the Stelvio climb at 150 km.

The food stops are placed at the side of the race route and at the top of the Stelvio. For the safety of all the participants, we will not hand out any bottles, food etc. You must stop at the refreshment areas carefully. Once you have finished your race, you can find additional refreshments at the **PASTA PARTY** in Bormio (Palazzo Pentagono).



ROAD TRAFFIC

After the passage of the first confirmed rider road closures at all junctions will be maintained for a period of 45 minutes. After this point traffic will be allowed to progress as normal but all junctions will be marshalled and whenever necessary traffic will be stopped to ensure the safety of all riders. Escort cars will be following all the riders. It is essential to respect the Laws of the Road, always stay on the right and pass on the left. Pay attention to the danger signs!



ROAD SIGNS

Road signs with indications of kilometers, dangers, food stops and repair service areas are placed at various points on the race routes. Please pay attention to all the signs! You will also find coloured arrows on the ground whenever there is a deviation.



FINISH

Once you finish, you'll be immediately directed to an area where you can change and refresh. Here you may find your clothing bag. Please pay attention to your race number, as the bags will be organized by race number.

RACE END

At the end of the race at Passo dello Stelvio, you are invited to return to Bormio at Palazzo Pentagono, where you can have a shower and enjoy a post-race meal at the Pasta Party. When descending, please pay attention to the people who are still completing the race, coming in the opposite direction. Always keep right and give way to the people climbing.



BEHAVIOUR

The Organizing Committee counts on many volunteers (race pack pick-up, crossroads operators, refreshment operators, mechanical services etc.). These people are very important for your safety and for the success of the race, therefore we ask you to show respect and kindness towards them.



RESPECT NATURE AND THE ENVIRONMENT

The Granfondo Stelvio Santini organizers kindly ask you not to throw away any waste along the race course. The penalty of disqualification from the race will apply. There are many organized green areas where you can throw away your garbage. Your Granfondo Stelvio Santini jersey has an extra pocket on the side. You can use it to keep your gel and bar wrappers, plus any other waste until you reach a green area.

Rankings and awards

The Granfondo Stelvio Santini is a competitive sport event and contemplates the following:

Total time detection → from start to finish, with alphabetical indication of each participant total time.

Ranking of the total time performed on the climbs with the indication of the absolute position and the category ranking for each route:

- **SHORT ROUTE:**
time on the Stelvio Climb
- **MEDIUM ROUTE:**
sum of the times on Teglio and Stelvio
- **LONG ROUTE:**
sum of times on Teglio, Mortirolo and Stelvio

The best man of each category will be awarded with the **KING OF THE MOUNTAIN Granfondo Stelvio Santini jersey**.

The best woman of each category will be awarded with the jersey **QUEEN OF THE MOUNTAIN Granfondo Stelvio Santini**.

Absolute ranking of time performed on each of the three climbs; **TEGLIO, MORTIROLO and STELVIO**.

The winners, men, first classified in the absolute ranking will be awarded with:

- **KING OF THE MOUNTAIN-TEGLIO** jersey sponsored by **RETELIT**
- **KING OF THE MOUNTAIN MORTIROLO** jersey sponsored by **TREK**
- **KING OF THE MOUNTAIN-STELVIO** jersey sponsored by **SANTINI**

The winners, women, first classified in the absolute ranking will be awarded with:

- **QUEEN OF THE MOUNTAIN-TEGLIO** jersey sponsored by **RETELIT**
- **QUEEN OF THE MOUNTAIN-MORTIROLO** jersey sponsored by **TREK**
- **QUEEN OF THE MOUNTAIN-STELVIO** jersey sponsored by **SANTINI**

We will also award:

- the first 3 teams with the **largest number of members participating** at the Granfondo
(excluding the organizing team **US BORMIESE**)
- the first team with the **largest number of athletes crossing the finish line**
- the **older and younger male and female** competitor.

The official award ceremony will take place at 4.00 pm inside the Granfondo Stelvio Santini Village at the Pentagono in Bormio.

Local Attractions

Discover ->

Bormio is a remote town nestled in the Stelvio National Park and close to the Swiss border. During the winter months it is a world famous 3000m ski and winter sports resort and a regular venue for the skiing World Cup; come the summer and it's a Mecca for cyclists thanks to its proximity to the epic Mortirolo and Stelvio climbs.

The town itself has been a spa town since Roman times and its fine 17th-Century centre continues to echo with history and atmosphere. Wandering through the streets you can discover Kuèrc Square with its Tower of the Hours, the Church of Santi Gervasio e Protasio, ancient wooden houses with intricate carvings, and more.

The mountains also offer the opportunity to get out there with every mountain sport you care to think of – from climbing to paragliding, trekking to mountain biking, and beyond.

Bormio

An alpine town nestled in the Stelvio national park

LOCAL FOOD

The Lombardy region has its own distinctive cuisine to that of the rest of Italy, with plenty of regional specialties that can be sampled in Bormio.

PIZZOCCHERI

A type of short tagliatelle, made from buckwheat flour and wheat flour. Traditionally cooked with Swiss Chard or Savoy cabbage and cubed potatoes. Valtellina Casera cheese and ground Grana Padano or Parmigiano Reggiano.

SCIATT

One of the typical dishes of the region, Sciatt means 'toad' in the local dialect; it's so-named because of its ugliness. The food itself is a piece of Bitto cheese – or Fontina – which is dipped in a light batter of buckwheat flour, grappa, and a local red beer, and deep fried.

MANFRIGOLE

This dish is a filled and rolled crepe made from buckwheat flour, eggs, and milk. The filling is made from bread soaked in milk, with Casera or Fontina cheese, and then coarsely chopped. This mixture is then combined with cream and seasoned, added to the crepes, and then rolled. The rolls are then cut into slices an inch or so thick, topped with a cube of cheese.

BRESAOLA DELLA VALTELLINA

Bresaola or brisaola is air-dried, salted beef that has been aged for three months until it becomes hard and turns a dark, almost purple, red. It's lean and tender, with a sweet, musty smell and is usually thinly sliced and served on its own as an antipasto, or sometimes drizzled with olive oil and lemon juice.

POST GRANFONDO (For descending the Stelvio Pass)

Remember to put these garments inside the clothing bag that you will find inside your race pack:

- Baselayer
- Long Sleeved jersey
- Bib-tights or leg warmers
- Winter jacket or windbreaker
- Winter Gloves
- Shoe covers
- Under helmet
- Backpack

Also don't forget to keep your GFSS bracelet or for the PASTA PARTY! Non participants who decide to come to the Pasta Party with you can purchase one for € 10 directly at the Pentagono in Bormio.

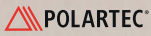
We have decided to donate one euro for each participant in the race to the Vento in Faccia organisation.
